



GENERAL INFORMATION

WHO WE ARE

The simonsays Arts and Culture Association is a nonprofit organization, with all staff members working on a voluntary basis. All proceeds from our activities, primarily concert events, go towards our association's purpose. Any surplus funds are donated to other charitable organizations.

AWARENESS GUIDELINE...

- Bringing outside drinks is not allowed on the festival grounds.
- There is a strict ban on xenophobia, racism, sexism, violence, pyrotechnics, weapons, and drugs.
- Self-control is key: Please be considerate in all your actions, know your limits, and respect your surroundings.

OPENING HOURS

- Friday: Admission from 16:00, drinks served until 02:00
- Saturday: Admission from 15:00, drinks served until 02:00

Your ticket (or day pass) will be scanned at the festival entrance, and you will receive an entry wristband. Please bring your ticket printed in A4 format to the event if possible. You can leave the premises at any time and re-enter later – no one-way ticket.

PAYMENT AT THE FESTIVAL

CASH ONLY! We only accept cash payments at the festival grounds. It's advisable to include a nearby ATM (approximately 10 minutes' walk away) in your plans.

NO CAMPING, SORRY!!!

Unfortunately, we are unable to provide a camping area at the event venue this year. Please inquire about nearby hotels, guesthouses, or public campsites.

ACCESSIBILITY

We strive to make the festival accessible, but we depend on local conditions.

- The driveway is asphalted, but there is a small step at the entrance. Please speak to us if you need assistance!

CHILD PROTECTION

Legal provisions for youth protection apply throughout the festival and camping area. Please note:

- Children up to 16 years old do not need a ticket and have free entry if accompanied by their parents (with a ticket) attending the festival.
- Children and adolescents under 16 years old are only admitted when accompanied by a legal guardian or an adult supervisor with a ticket.
- A youth protection form must always be carried on the entire festival and camping area. The accompanying person must be able to identify themselves at all times.

- Consumption of alcohol is prohibited for youths under 16 years old, and consumption of high-proof beverages is prohibited for youths under 18 years old.
- Pay special attention to adequate hearing protection, especially for children.
